The current facility fee is \$8.00 per horse, per day or part thereof.

#### For \$8 you get:

- \* safe and secure places to ride
- \* quality, maintained sand and grass arenas
- \* access to obstacles to test your horse
- \* water to wash your horse and for drinking
- \* power if your horse needs clipping
- \* lights if you can only ride at night
- \* a friendly meeting place
